


Device overview

- 5 Holder

Getting started

- Switch on the computer and all connected peripheral devices (monitor, printer etc.) and wait until the operating system is fully started.
- Open up the holder and clip the webcam onto the top of your monitor as shown.



- ▶ Connect the webcam to a free USB port on your computer.
- Drivers are installed automatically.

There is a thread on the underside of the holder for use with a tripod.

- ▶ Close the holder and screw the webcam onto the tripod.
- ▶ Tap the lighting touch switch several times to set the desired lighting level.
